


What is VOP (Verification of Payee)?



Verification of Payee (VoP) is a fraud-prevention service designed to confirm that the account name and IBAN provided by a payer match the payee's actual bank account details—before a payment is authorized or executed.


This added layer of verification is especially important for instant payments, which are both immediate and irrevocable, leaving little room to reverse fraudulent transactions.


VoP helps ensure that funds are sent to the intended recipient, reducing the risk of fraud and misdirected payments.








Payment processing in Nomentia with VOP

Is VOP mandatory?

VOP is not mandatory for end users, but banks are required to offer the service.

Is VOP mandatory for Nomentia?

No, it's not mandatory for Nomentia.

However, we aim to integrate with banks that offer VOP to deliver an outstanding service to our customers.

Will Nomentia support all banks in all countries by October 9th?

No, we will prioritize banks that are able to provide specifications for their VOP services.

Coverage will expand as more banks make their services available.

How should customers prepare for VOP?

We recommend starting with the Opt-Out process to ensure the continuity of your payment operations. VOP can enhance payment security, so consider when and how it should be applied in your organization.

Also, ensure your invoicing data includes the correct legal name to avoid payment issues,

especially when counterparties use VOP.
